## **The Apostles Creed**

## **The Reformed Faith**

- SCRIPTURE ALONE – The Bible being God’s inspired Word is the only infallible authority for doctrine and life (2 Tim. 3:16-17).
- GRACE ALONE – “by grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God, not of works” (Eph. 2:8-9). Even the faith to believe in Jesus is God’s gift (Phil. 1:29).
- FAITH ALONE – Jesus said, “He who *believes* in Me has everlasting life” (John 6:47). Faith in Christ leads the believer to do good works out of thankfulness for salvation (Eph. 2:10).
- CHRIST ALONE – Christ’s one sacrifice on the cross fully paid the penalty for sin, leaving no penalty for us to pay (John 19:30; Acts 20:28; 1 Tim. 2:5; Heb. 7:27).
- GLORY TO GOD ALONE – God alone deserves all the glory for our salvation (Rom. 11:33). Jesus said to His followers, “You did not choose Me, but I chose you” (John 15:16).
