EXODUS: THE BIG PICTURE

“Israel’s slavery in Egypt is a picture of misery [the misery of sin’s bondage]; their departure from Egypt through the sea to the ratification of the covenant at Sinai is a picture of deliverance; and their commitment to obey the law and to worship at the tabernacle were pictures of gratitude for grace” (Michael Barrett, *The Gospel of Exodus*, 248-249).
